Fever free for 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medication Such as: Tylenol, Motrin, ibuprofen	Free from vomiting for 24 hours after the last episode without use of medication	Free from diarrhea for 24 hours after the last episode without use of medication	Free from rash, itching and fever (fever free for 24 hours) and I have a doctor's note to return to school	Examined by a doctor, 24 hours after antibiotic started and I have a doctor's note to return to school	Released by my medical provider and I have a doctor's note to return to school

Do not send your child to school for the nurse to check his/her temperature.

If sick, keep them home, please. You are exposing everyone else at school.

If you send your child to school with the above illnesses, you will be called to pick up your child.

Strep throat, impetigo and pink eye (bacterial) require 24 hours of antibiotics at home before returning to school.
